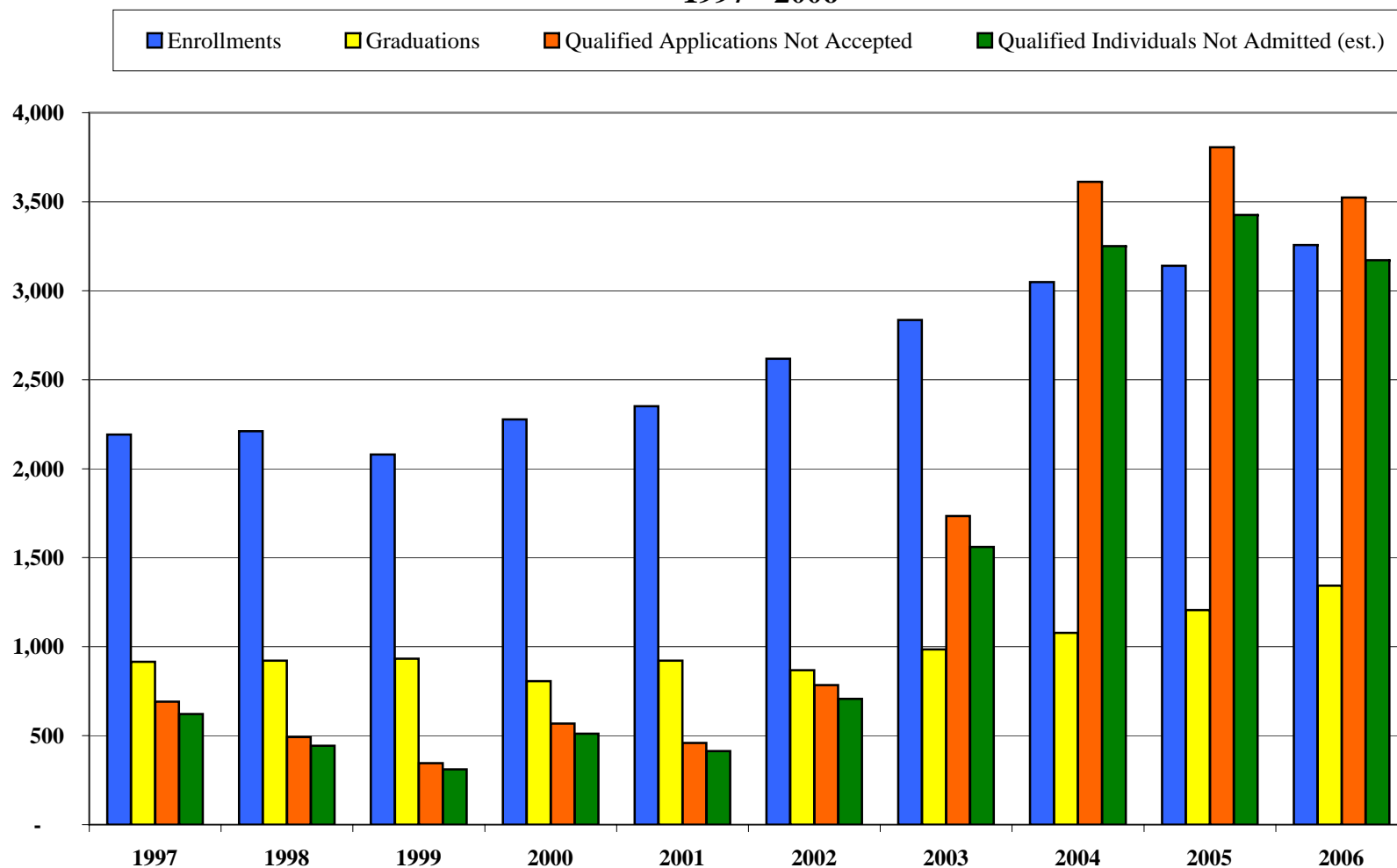
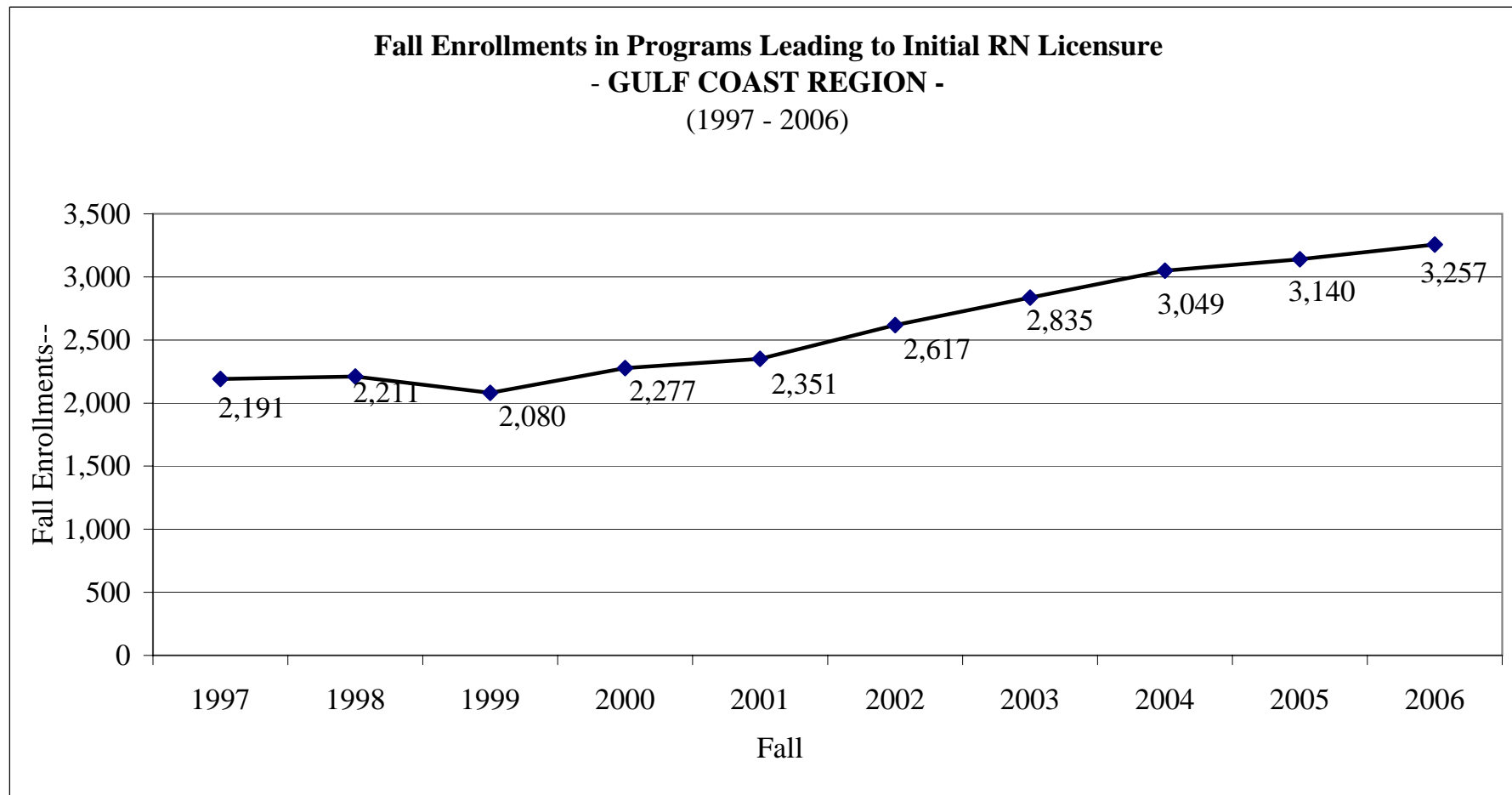


## Enrollments, Graduations, and Qualified Applications Not Accepted and Individuals Not Admitted to Initial RN Licensure Programs in the Gulf Coast Region 1997 - 2006



**Graduations, qualified applications not accepted, and individuals not admitted are reported for each academic year. Enrollments are reported for the fall of each year.**

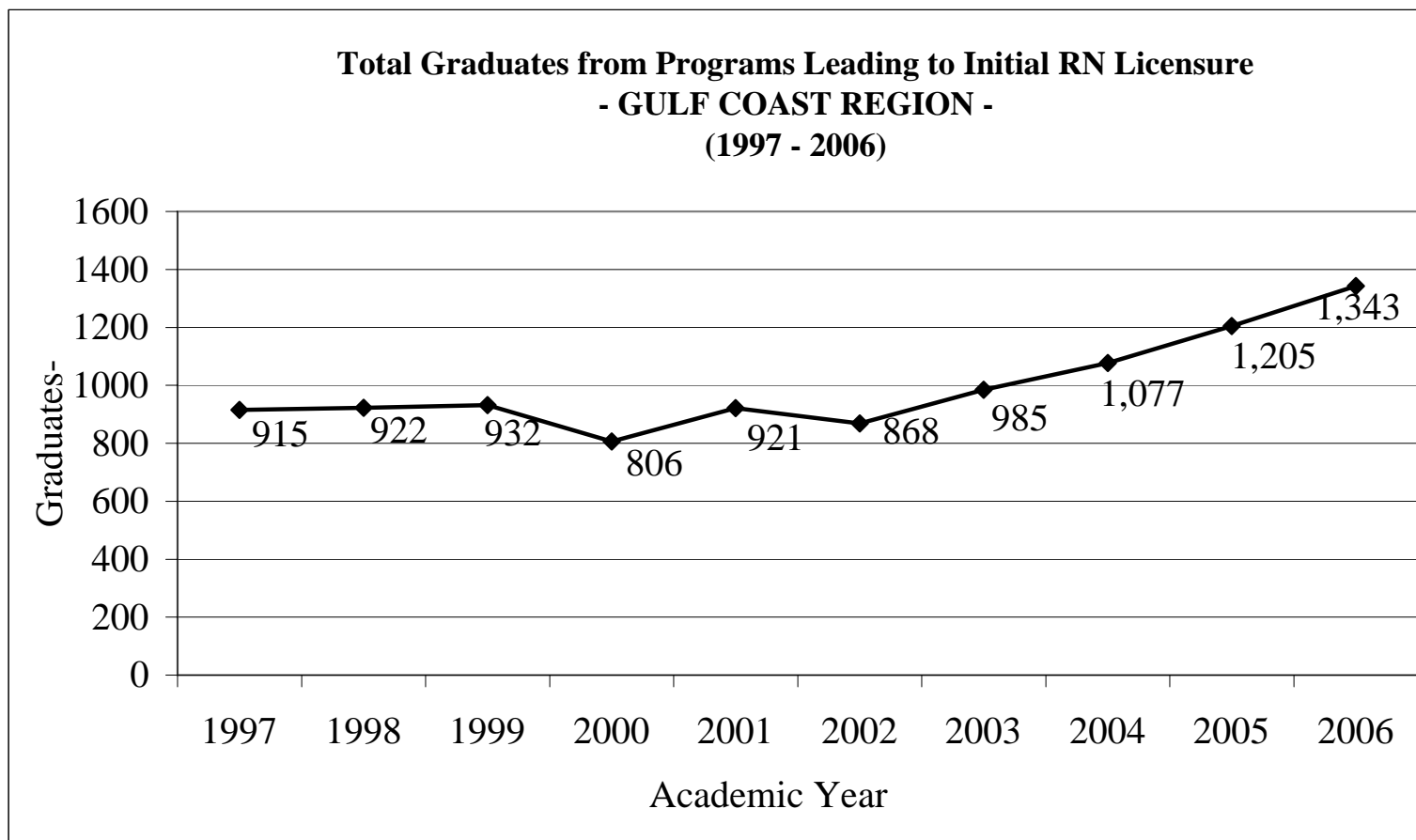

The numbers for fall enrollments were calculated by subtracting RNs in generic programs and RNs on a BSN track from total enrollment (in BNE data tables, Enrollment Total minus RN Gen Prog minus RN BSN Track).

**Fall 2006 enrollments are up 980 or 43 percent above Fall 2000.**

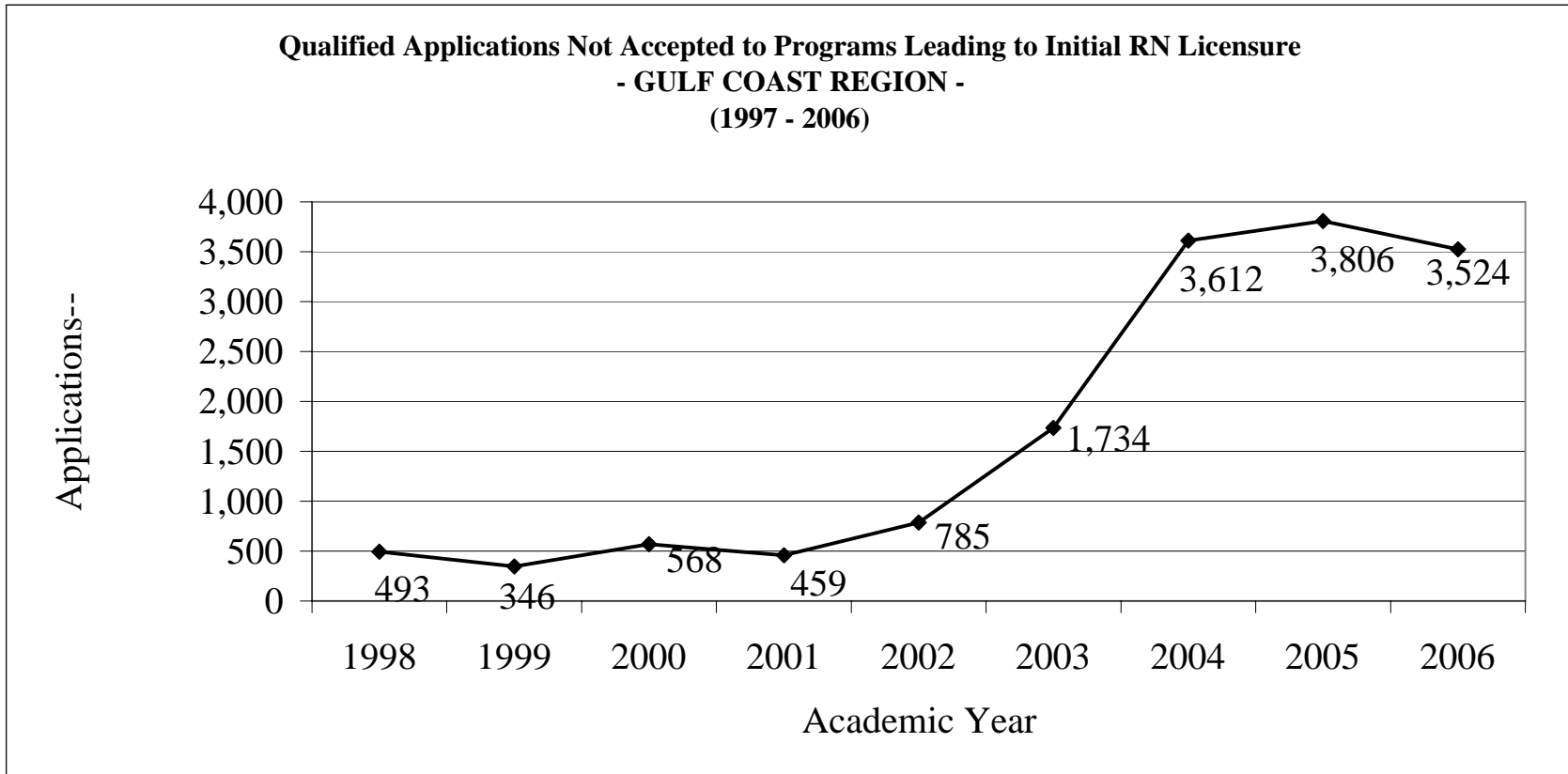

<sup>1</sup> Figures come from annual reports Gulf Coast nursing programs make to BNE and reported by BNE in Student Enrollment and Graduation Data tables for each year. The numbers for Qualified Applications Not Accepted were calculated by subtracting the number offered admission from the number of qualified applications received for a given academic year (in BNE data tables, under Admission: # Qual App minus # Adm). These figures are inflated because some students apply to more than one school. Beginning with 2005, BNE changed language as follows: rather than the number of qualified applications *received for an academic year*, the measure now reads the number of qualified applicants for admission *into the academic year*. The calculation otherwise remains the same.

Applying that rate to the number of qualified applications not accepted for the Gulf Coast region provides the estimated number of individual applicants not admitted shown here.

**Estimated number of qualified applications not accepted for academic year 2005 - 2006 is up 2,956 or 520 percent above 1999 - 2000.  
Individual applicants not admitted are up 2,661 or 520 percent.**
